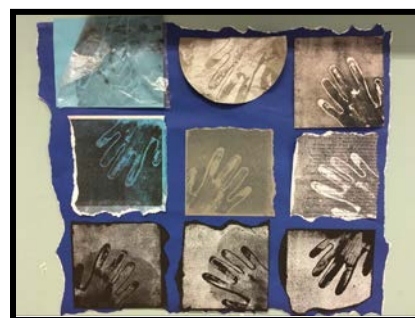
The Schedule

Workshop Details

Area	Run by	Description
Lower Years Visual Arts	Mike Oszczypala Angela Daly (Amsterdam International Community School)	<u>Matisse's Garden</u> Inspired by the book 'Matisse's garden', we will explore how to engage students' imagination, experiences and senses to create their own garden, collaboratively and/or individually. We will look at colour, shape, and texture through drawing, cutting, collage and printing. We will also be able to see how other areas of the arts can be incorporated through this theme.
Upper Years Visual Arts	Mike Oszczypala Angela Daly (Amsterdam International Community School)	<u>Aboriginal Instruments</u> Looking at aboriginal art and the stories they tell, we will explore how we can use this and create musical instruments to tell our own story about nature. How can we fuse music and the visual arts together? We will delve into 3-dimensional work, drawing and painting.
Lower Years Music	Teresa Matias (Muziekschool Amsterdam)	<u>Music - Through Nature and Inquiry</u> Using nature themed song repertoire, the teachers will walk away with some great tools, strategies and resources for teaching Music.
Upper Years Music	Rasjad Addison (Amsterdam International Community School)	<u>Co-Creating a Nature/Class Song</u> All going to plan, in only 45 minutes we will write a mini-song together, and you will leave with the tools and experience to write a song with your class. Rock on!
Lower Years Dance	Micheline van der Vlugt (Amsterdam International Community School)	<u>Active Imagination</u> We will use our imaginations to make stories come alive. The workshop will engage the participants and allow them to experience the magic of movement and active storytelling.
Upper Years Dance	Cristy Kilkeary (Amsterdam International Community School)	<u>Moving Concepts</u> This workshop will show participants how dance and movement can enhance and expand the inquiry that is happening in the classroom. Participants will be contacted prior to the workshop so that the workshop can cater to the interests of the participants.
